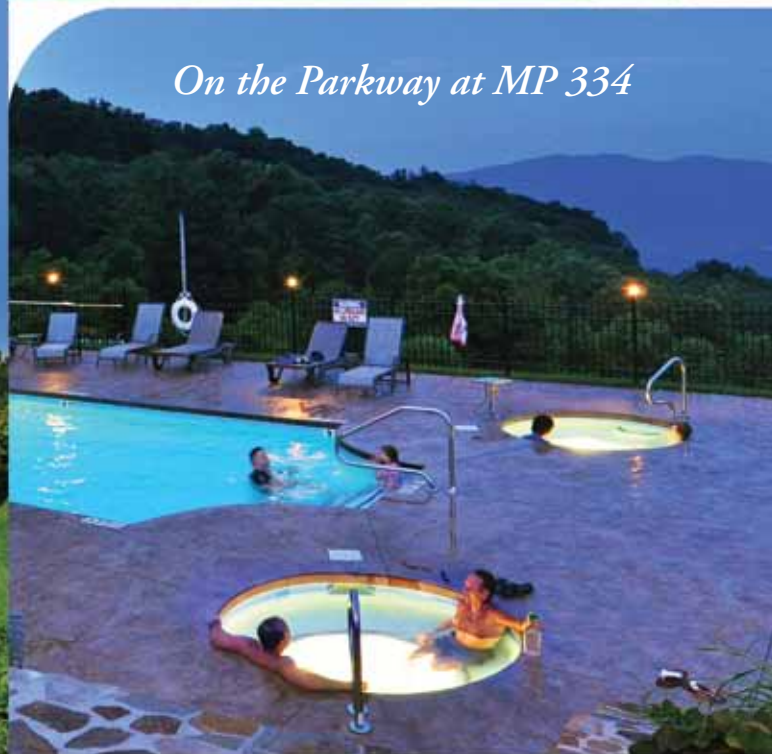

Mitchell (the tallest peak east of the Rockies) and Grandfather Mountain (with the mile-high swinging bridge) at Mile Post 334, the Switzerland Inn features 72 mountain-view suites, private chalets, a honeymoon cottage and the Diamondback Motorcycle Lodge.

Unwind in the swimming pool and hot tubs at the edge of our mountain valley view or enlist our on-site tennis pro for personal instruction. RATES

All rates quoted are per day, based on two people (except A-frames and Balsam), and do not include taxes. Published rates are subject to availability and change. Extra person charge:

Reservations on holiday weekends, the first two weekends in August and weekends in October will be subject to a two-night minimum and a \$30 rate premium.

RESERVATIONS AND DEPOSITS

Reservations must be guaranteed with a deposit equal to your first night's charges for each room reserved. This deposit is charged to your credit card on the day you make the reservation. The deposit is applied to the last night reserved.

CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

We have a 10-day cancellation policy with a \$20 fee. If you give us at least 10 days notice we will issue a refund minus \$20 for each room cancelled. If you give less than 10 days notice, we will keep the entire deposit. Early departures are considered cancellations of reserved days.

SMOKING

We are a smoke-free facility. Smoking is not permitted in rooms.

PETS

Pets are allowed in the A-frame cottages and the Swiss apartments ONLY. There will be an additional fee of \$20 per day.

TWO-STORY MAIN LODGE

When speaking of the Switzerland Inn, this is what most people visualize. The lobby is spacious with a beautiful flagstone floor and fireplace. Big picture windows allow you to gaze at one of the most magnificent mountain views in the region. All rooms have a rich-toned wainscoting and hand-painted mural that beckons you to the Swiss Alps. Recent renovations make these rooms beautifully appointed and comfortable. Most have balconies; all are air-conditioned, have cable TV, phone and private bath.

CHANTICLEER BUILDINGS I & II

These buildings sit on the point of the property at the site of the original Switzerland Inn. The rooms are large with a king or two queen beds and a sitting area with a sleeper sofa and chairs. Each room is air-conditioned and has a deck overlooking the mountains. Chanticleer I has eight rooms, each with two queen beds. Chanticleer II has a little better view and eight rooms as well. The four upstairs rooms have two queen beds. The four downstairs rooms have king beds and are handicapped equipped.

HEIDI AND ALPINE SUITES

These buildings sit next to the Main Lodge and they back up to the restaurant and old Buchanan burial ground. These are large suites with air conditioning and separate sleeping and living areas. A large deck gives you a mountain view that is spectacular. Maximum occupancy is two unless authorized by the manager.

INDIVIDUAL COTTAGES

Our cottages are our most rustic units, nestled in the rhododendrons and mountain laurel and remain our most popular units. Our cottages give you the flavor of the mountains and offer a higher level of privacy. There is no mountain view from our cottages.

THE DIAMONDBACK MOTORCYCLE LODGE

Just renovated, the Diamondback Motorcycle Lodge is an eight-room cabin with covered motorcycle parking. Rooms have two twin beds, or one double, TV and a private bath. The Diamondback Motorcycle Lodge is not air-conditioned and there are no phones.

A-FRAMES

A-frames are chalet style units with a small living area, air-conditioning, bedroom with king bed and a downstairs bath. Spiral stairs lead to the sleeping loft, which contains a double bed. The loft is not suitable for very young children or the elderly. We have found the A-frames are best suited for a family of four with two children ages 6-13. Rates are based on four-person occupancy. Our A-frames are pet friendly. An additional pet fee of \$20 per day will apply.

BALSAM

Balsam was once the manager's cottage for the original Switzerland Inn. A bark covered cottage, this is a great choice for those needing space and privacy. It contains a living area, two bedrooms, two baths, four double beds, gas fireplace, air-conditioning and a front porch. Rates are based on four-person occupancy.

SWISS

The Swiss is a lovely apartment cottage with a kitchen, washer and dryer and a deck with a grill. The cottage has a spacious living area and there is a king bed in the bedroom with air-conditioning.
